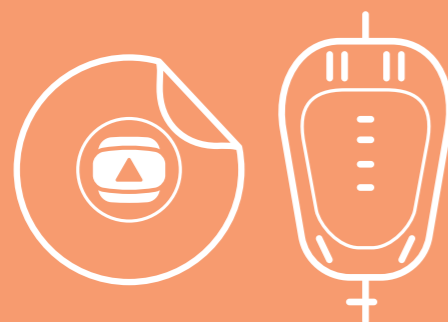

The **Ugo Pro** comes with 3 pairs of gloves, which is the required amount for best practice catheter removal and insertion.

The drapes included in the **Ugo Pro** are different colours for easy differentiation.

THE UGO PRO CONTAINS:

- 1 Clear instructions for use.
- 2 1x outer wrapper – creates an aseptic field for the components to be placed upon.
- 3 1x disposable apron.
- 4 1x waste bag.
- 5 1x grey waterproof drape – protects the bed from spilt fluids during procedure. Assists with aseptic technique.
- 6 1x blue waterproof "O" drape – provides dignity during the procedure. Assists with aseptic technique.
- 7 1x 10ml empty syringe – to remove fluid from Foley catheter balloon prior to catheter removal.
- 8 6x non-woven swabs – to assist with removal and general catheterisation procedure technique.
- 9 5x non-woven balls – for cleansing catheter insertion site during procedure (once coated in saline).
- 10 1x 20ml saline cleansing pod (0.9% w/v sodium chloride) – to empty over non-woven balls for cleansing catheter insertion site.
- 11 1x clear tray with 2 compartments.
- 12 3x pairs of medium nitrile **Ugo Pro** gloves – assists with aseptic technique.
